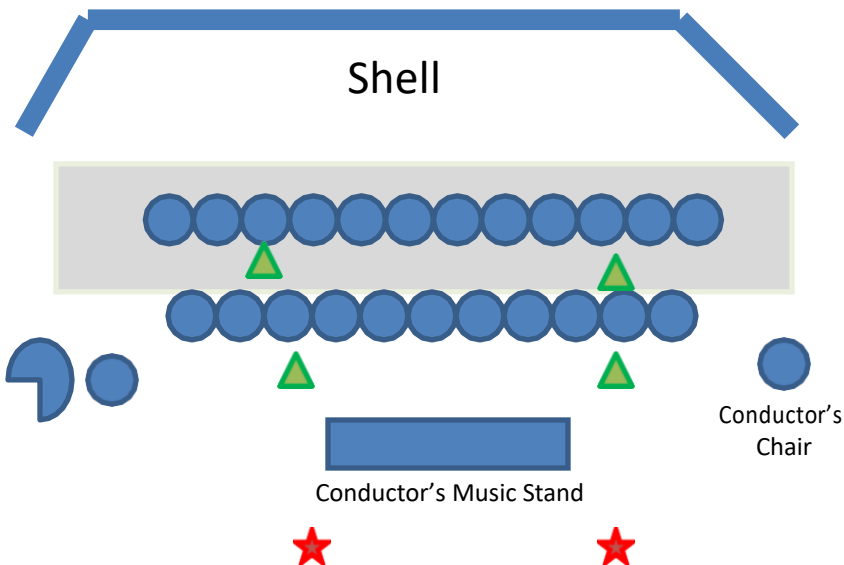
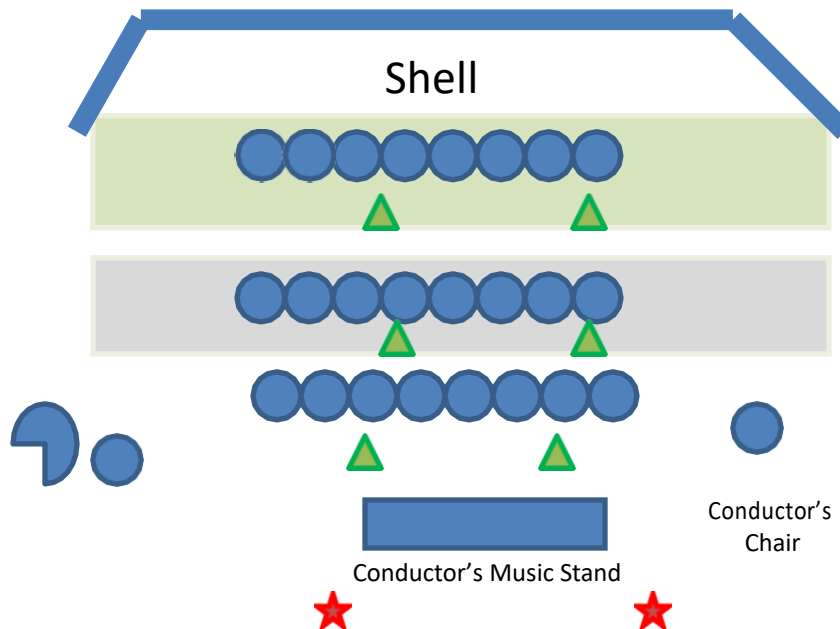


American Spiritual Ensemble (ASE): Stage Set-up and Sound Check Instructions

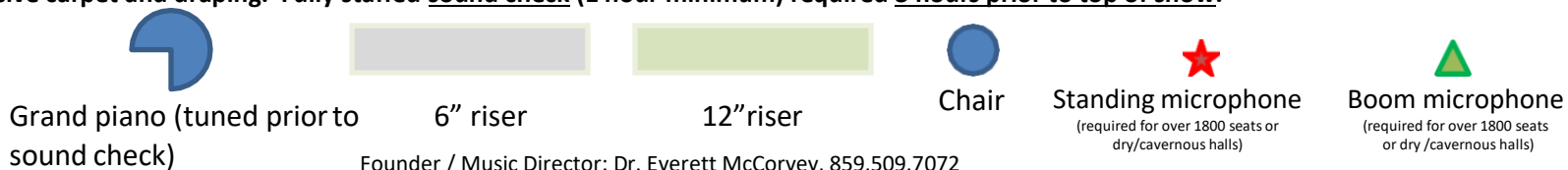
ASE Set-up Option A

Note: Five (5) chair height (or counter height) stools should be placed in stage left wing. Bottled water to be placed under each chair following sound check or prior to opening the house. Stairs for group to exit downstage to orchestra level aisles is requested where available. Escape stairs/platforms should be placed behind back of risers for soloists to exit/enter group as needed. Stairs should be placed for side access to risers over 6" in height. Chair rail should be placed on upper most risers and other risers as needed to assure chair legs are protected from slippage. ASE set-up for performances in church sanctuaries can be modified to use altar stairs and choir seating. Amplification required for halls with seating capacity greater than 1800. Some amplification may required in halls that have excessive carpet and draping. Fully staffed sound check (1 hour minimum) required 3 hours prior to top of show.
